

LOGOMARK


Use primary full color logo as main and use light color logo on dark background. Maintaining a consistent appearance of the logo is crucial. It should not be altered, misrepresented, or embellished in any way.





CLEAR SPACE

A clear space around the logo ensures that it remains prominent and easily visible, free from interference by images, text, or other graphics. The more space you provide for our logo, the more impactful it will be. The exclusion zone for the logo is defined as an area equal to the height of the logo itself (marked as 'x' in the diagram).



MINIMUM SIZES

The version is optimized for sizes that are not excessively small. It mandates a minimum height of .75" for print applications and a minimum of 30px for digital applications, ensuring legibility and clarity even at larger dimensions.



TYPE STACK
